ETHIOPIA - Recently the Ethiopian Ambassador responsible for approving shipments of 40' Containers was SO pleased with our partner's plans and organization with FAME's help – that he requested they ship 3 Containers instead of 1!

D.R. OF CONGO - An open door of shipping with no government taxes and fees opened because of the pandemic; FAME has and is outfitting 3 ministries and 15+ clinics because of you!

GHANA - A pediatric and adult Cardiac Care Center will be able to complete construction and open as soon as the government lifts current COVID restrictions. This is a project which was funded in 2020!

MOZAMBIQUE - The equipment and supplies sent to a partner positioned them to become the COVID-19 treatment site for a city of 1.5 Million people! South Africa Durban

## EUROPE & MIDDLE EAST

Ukraine Jordan UKRAINE - In war-torn Ukraine, over 3500 home-bound elderly women received necessary items from a FAME partner with 43 volunteers delivering help and hope.

### **PACIFIC REGION**

Papua New Guinea Philippines PHILIPPINES - Mobile Clinic which now goes to churches and offers routine patient care, lab services, maternity care, and immunizations. Previously, when a critical care patient arrived at the churches, not being able to transport them to a Hospital was a Crisis.

Cambodia China India Japan Myanmar Nepal Pakistan Thailand MYANMAR - Provided material for children's home to sew masks for thousands in their community

INDIA - Replaced the Mobile Clinic which FAME provided in 2004. SICM planted 60 churches which can be directly linked to FAME, being the spark that opened the door for the gospel!

NEPAL - 2 Shipping Containers of hospital beds and equipment (beds donated by Franciscan Health).

MULTIPLE - Supplied clinics when all other sources were out of supplies during pandemic.

COLOMBIA - The last pre-pandemic short-term trip of 2020 saw new doors open for the gospel on this trip with a new partner.

HONDURAS - The FAME acquired ambulance became the only means of transportation for Clinic Staff to come and go through roadblocks for health emergencies, getting to the clinic, and then delivering food to villages.

BOLIVIA - Mobility supplies bring hope to the ministry there for the hundreds of patients with no mobility equipment and supplies
