## SUPPORTING SUSTAINABLE PROJECTS

It is well known that Kisumu villages in the western part of Kenya along Lake Victoria are some of the poorest villages in Kenya. Most of the residents lack access to basic services including electricity, schools, medical care, running water, and public lavatories. As a result, it is heavily polluted and many suffer from water borne diseases and other ailments such as Malaria, Cholera, HIV/AIDS, TB, poor mother child health, and hunger. The lack of a well-equipped medical facility, combined with poor nutrition accounts for many of the preventable and treatable illnesses and diseases the people suffer from.

In the meantime, thousands of Kisumu village residents will die of malnutrition and preventable or treatable diseases. The most seriously impacted are the multitudes of children, especially those under five years of age.

### An immediate solution is needed!

This project is a \$20,000 grant toward building a private sector Christian health FAME clinic in Kisumu village of Western Kenya along the Lake Victoria region that will treat approximately 5,000 - 10,000 patients per year. The health clinic will be staffed by Kenyans, and a sustainability plan in place!

The Medical clinic will provide health and humanitarian services in each of the following seven disciplines:

1. Rapid test whole blood laboratory screening for Diabetes, HIV, Malaria, Syphilis, and H.pylori.
2. Medical and Dental exams and treatment, focusing on Primary Care of acute and chronic conditions, infectious diseases, prenatal care, pediatric care, and maternal care.
3. Distribution of up to 2,000 US AID approved fortified food packages (50 servings each), as needed to visiting families.
4. Distribution of Chlorine Bleach and household water filters for wellness and disease prevention along with ongoing community and family Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) training.
5. Encourage partnerships with other interested humanitarian organizations
6. Carry Evangelism and Discipleship to 10,000 people per year
7. Implementing products and solutions of Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH project) as social enterprise

## HIS HEALING HANDS MINISTRIES MEDICAL CLINIC AND WELLNESS CENTER



Paul Owino, the Kenyan operations Director/Founder, has been intimately involved in the remote village community for over 15 years. He was raised there as a boy and has observed first hand the unhealthy living conditions. He has observed children dying from malnutrition and preventable and treatable diseases. His own father is a victim of water borne parasites from the water there. The church he still attends is in the heart of a remote rural village and is a testimony of what is and what could be.

A FAME clinic will provide affordable services to the Kisumu Community eight hours a day, five days a week, and 50 weeks during the year. It is expected that at least 40 people (8 families) will be provided treatment in at least one of the following four areas every day during 2021- 2022: Prevention, Treatment, Humanitarian aid, and Partnerships. Service will be provided regardless of tribal origin or religious creed. All services provided will be documented to the appropriate department of health in Kenya.

This project is a mission-based project. All the patients visiting the clinic for physical treatment will be prayed for and given counselling leading to winning souls for Christ. In addition, we will use this to plant a local church in the remote village where the clinic is situated.

Last but not least, we will be using a CHE approach to get community members fully involved. For example, already there is an on-going disease prevention program that has been initiated. This will be scaled up within the project for a greater impact.

With the operational medical clinic in place, it will be a great entry point to minister to both body and soul. The patients and care givers visiting the clinic will be prayed for and given Gospel tracks. Those waiting to see the doctor will be watching Christian teachings and movies in the clinic waiting area.

The staff will be trained on how to use this opportunity to evangelize to the people they interact with at the facility.

*I started with disease prevention program and evangelism that is water-sanitation related diseases has been on rise along Lake Victoria region in Kisumu and have been teaching hygiene and implementing solutions on water treatment and improved sanitation.*

*Prevention alone is not enough because many people are infected with the disease and the health facility that are available are several miles away, they are not using the services as Medical Evangelism and they are not properly equipped with both medicine and equipment.*
