### THE MISSION

You are partnering with Dr. Esly and Dr. Sandy Fuentes, of World Wide Hispanic Outreach, to build a medical hospital near Saltillo, Mexico. The name of the ministry, World Wide Hispanic Outreach, explains their focus exactly; to reach out to their brothers and sisters for Christ. The WWHO ministry began in the inner city of Saltillo and has grown to serve Mexico, the Caribbean, and the United States. In 2008, FAME sent equipment and supplies for the first clinic that opened in February 2009. Now, 4 clinics serve the medical and dental needs of the rural farming village of, la Biznaga, and other surrounding villages, located southeast of Saltillo in the Sierra Madre Mountains.

### **NEW MISSION HOSPITAL**



#### **PROJECT**

- Hospital interior and exterior plaster
- Weatherproofing
- Doors and windows

#### SUSTAINABILITY FACTORS

- The Community Health Evangelism (CHE) model is already being used in the clinic and villages served by WWHO.
- Funding Sources: Service fees based on a sliding scale.
- Income generated by labs, medical specialists, pharmaceutical and dental services.
- Wholesale medicine and medical supplies are acquired regionally.



#### Current Phase- \$40,000

The new hospital facility will provide immediate and ongoing medical care to the surrounding rural communities. The total project will provide 15 patient beds, on-site medical, dental, and x-ray labs, an emergency room, a maternity wing and a surgical suite. Their vision is to start a nursing school that will help provide patient care and generate revenue. Nursing students would be funded by scholarships from churches in the United States. The annual Hospital budget is projected to be \$80,000 to \$100,000 and self-sufficient in 5 to 10 years.
